- Prof. Dr. Michael Krüger from Münster/Germany is honored with the ISHPES Award
 - Gigliola Gori Junior Scholar Award
 - Emanuel Hübner (Germany) and Victoria Felkner (Canada) have won the Gigliola Gori Junior Scholar Award
 - Gigliola Gori donates 1000 € each year for the Gigliola Gori Junior Scholar Award
 - Routledge Presentation Award
 - The Routledge Presentation Award for Young Scholars was won by Shahrzad Mohammadi (Iran/Germany) and Shunsuke Matsuo (Japan)
 - they receive a £75 voucher from Routledge
 - at each conference there is a special group who attends the paper given by students to evaluate them for the award

5) Collaboration with Routledge

- Since 2014 each member gets the possibility to have access to the year's online version of the The International Journal of the History of Sport (IJHS) (Routledge).
 - The IJHS has now published the second special issue in 2014 with selected papers of the 2013 ISHPES conference in Taipei
